She tapes off criss-cross sections to keep paint off those areas. She uses Halloween Cheese Cloth and Joint Compound to add texture. The Joint Compound needs to dry for 24 hours.

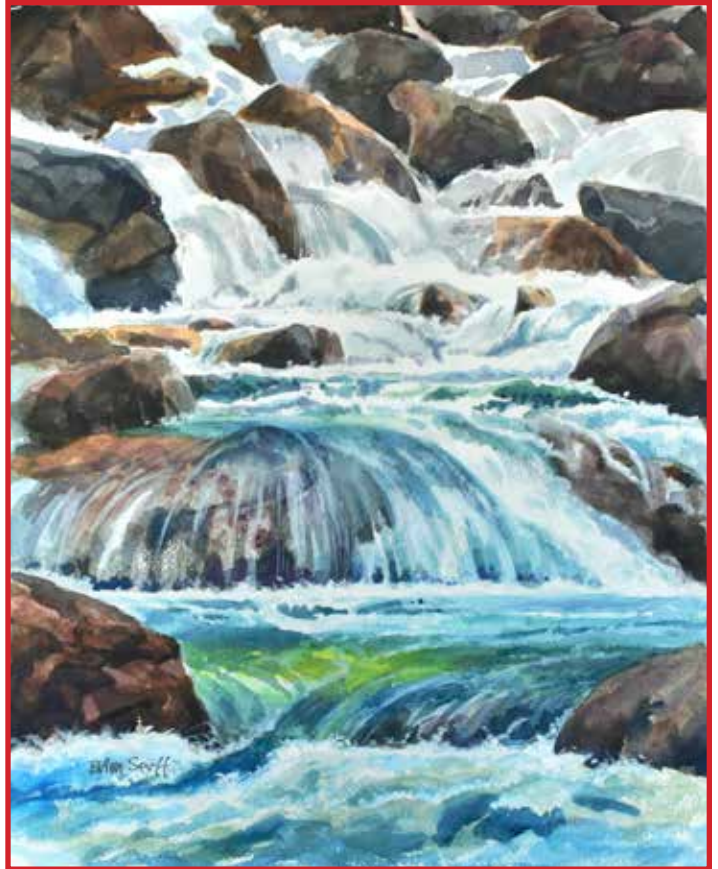
